Parent Information Note:

Staff accompanying students on excursions will take all reasonable care while the students are in their charge to protect them from injury and to control and supervise their behaviour and activities. - In order to transport your child to or from an excursion in the event of a behavioural incident.
- In the event of an emergency as identified by the Principal or Acting Principal of the school.
- A designated staff member of Rockingham Beach Education Support Centre will be identified to transport your child to or from an
 excursion in the event of a behavioural incident or emergency.
- I am aware that staff members are not responsible for injuries or damage to property which may occur during transit where, in all circumstances, staff have not been negligent.
