Basketball – Incursion – Kindy to Year 6

As part of our health and physical education curriculum program, students from Kindy to Year 6 have the opportunity to participate in basketball program. Adapted for the school setting, Ford Aussie Hoops, introduces students to basketball with a national accredited coaching curriculum. The program consists of warm-ups games, skill activities and modified games all delivered by accredited coaches.

The program will be comprised of 4 lessons, with students learning how to play basketball and enhancing their fundamental movement skills along with their locomotor and object control skills with a trained professional. It will increase aerobic capacity and cardiovascular health, build student strength, flexibility, and endurance.
