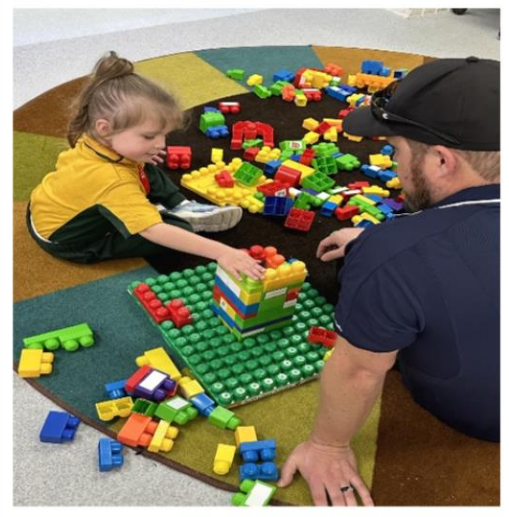

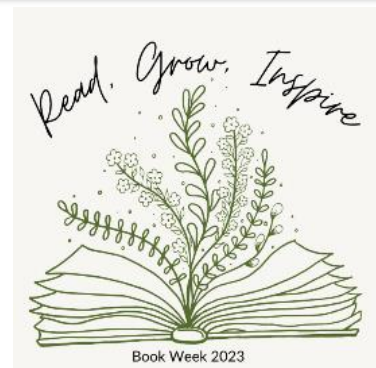
EC3 Father's Day Morning.

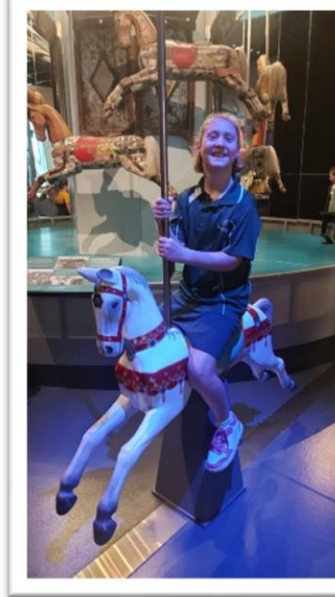
IGA Excursions
